

Special Council Meeting, Council Chambers,
December 10, 2008, 5:30 P.M.

The West Union City Council met on December 10, 2008, at 5:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers with Mayor Merlin Dunt presiding. The meeting began with citing the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Attendance Roll call: Present – Councilmembers Halva, Guenther, Schott, Rue, and Dyke
- Approval of Agenda Motion was made by Schott, seconded by Guenther, to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call. All voted aye. Carried.
- Approval of Community Development Block Grant for Kaleidoscope Kids Vicky Bloxham, Community Development Specialist, approached the Council with a more complete application to submit on behalf of the Kaleidoscope Kids for a Community Development Block Grant for construction of a new daycare center. The City would act as the fiscal agent only for the funds of the \$500,000 grant. Council member Troy Schott asked City Attorney Jerem White if he had any concerns with the wording in the agreements. White advised he was reviewing similar Sub recipient Agreements and would like to change the wording in that. Martin and Vicky agreed to get together and make the necessary changes on Thursday morning.
- After further discussion, a motion was made by Halva, seconded by Schott, to authorize the Mayor to sign the Community Development Block Grant Application on behalf of the City. The motion also authorized Vicky Bloxham and City Administrator Martin Games to update the Community Development and Housing Needs Assessment statement that needs to be included with the grant application. Roll call.
