

Council Minutes, Council Chambers, July 19, 2010, 5:30 P.M.

The West Union City Council met on July 19, 2010, at 5:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall with Mayor Merlin Dunt presiding.

- Attendance Roll call: Present – Councilmembers Guenther, Halva, Schott and Rue. Absent – City Attorney Jerem White, City Administrator Bob Vagts, and Councilman Dyke
- Approval of Agenda Motion was made by Guenther, seconded by Halva, to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call. All voted Aye. Carried.
- Approval of Minutes Motion was made by Schott, seconded by Halva, to approve the minutes of the July 6, 2010 regular meeting. Roll call. All voted Aye. Carried.
- Update on Downtown Project Jon Biederman, Tekippe Engineering, advised the opening of the bids will be at 10 a.m. Wednesday, July 21st at city hall. The public hearing for acceptance of the bids will be Monday, July 26th at 5:30 p.m. at city hall. No other action needed at this time.
- Discuss Property Acquisition for City Shop Rory Starks approached council and advised a new city shop is not high on his priority list, but his concern is where materials are going to be stored during the Streetscape project, and where the concrete and material torn out of the streets will be dumped. Kevin & Pam Cline have offered to sell the property on Echo Valley Road for a potential site, and may be interested in the current city shop for their use. Schott asked if the property could potentially be leased, and Cline’s responded in favor if the property had not sold by then. Council was not ready to take any action at this time.
- Approval of June Financials Motion was made by Schott, seconded by Guenther, to approve the June financials as presented. Roll call. All voted Aye. Carried.
- Special Council Meeting A special council meeting will be held July 26th at 5:30 p.m. to hold a public hearing on bid acceptance for the Streetscape project.
- Next Meeting Next regular council meeting will be Monday, August 2, 2010 in the council chambers at 5:30 p.m.
