

Council Chambers, City Hall, December 1st, 2014, 6:00 P.M.

West Union City Council met December 1st, 2014 at 6:00 P.M. in Council Chambers with Mayor Kent Halverson presiding. The meeting began with citing the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Attendance Roll call: Present – Council members Keller, Gumm, Bemiss, Granger and Stansbery Absent: None
- Approval of the Agenda Motion was made by Stansbery, seconded by Granger, to approve the agenda as presented. All Aye. Carried.
- Approval of the Minutes Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Keller, to approve minutes of the November 17th, 2014 regular meeting. All Aye. Carried.
- NIMS Certification Discussion In order to comply with FEMA in the case of a disaster in our town, the Mayor, Council, and City staff will need to become NIMS certified (National Instant Management System). This was put in place after Hurricane Katrina. Requirement is for the 100 & 700, which is available online. EMA director, Mike Foland is working to set up classes for 300 & 400 training, which will probably be held in March, for anyone willing to be in command positions in case of a disaster. All our firemen have the 100 & 700 training at this time.
- Approve Resolution 2015-20 for NIMS Emergency Management Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Keller, to approve Resolution 2015-20, adopting the NIMS concept of emergency planning and unified command for use in the City of West Union. All Aye. Carried.
- Approve Contract Between Swim Team And Park & Rec Swim Team President, Emily Koch and Park & Rec director, Kathy Guyer, have combined efforts to create a contract for the use of the West Union pool for calendar year 2015-2016. Motion was made by Stansbery, seconded by Granger, to approve the contract as presented. All Aye. Carried.
- Approve Resolution 2015-21 Approving The Annual Urban Renewal Report This is the Annual Urban Renewal Report for the FY 13-14 to file with the Department of Management regarding our TIF Agreements. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Granger, to approve as presented. All Aye. Carried.
- Update on Police Chief Brent Parker's Resignation Mayor Kent Halverson reported that Police Chief Brent Parker submitted a letter of resignation effective January 9th, 2015. The Police Committee will meet after Council to start the hiring process to find his replacement.
