West Union City Council met November 3rd, 2014 at 6:00 P.M. in Council Chambers with Mayor Kent Halverson presiding. The meeting began with citing the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Attendance Roll call: Present – Council members Keller, Gumm, Bemiss, Granger and Stansbery Absent: None
- Approval of the Agenda Motion was made by Keller, seconded by Granger, to approve the agenda as presented. All Aye. Carried.
- Approval of the Minutes Motion was made by Granger, seconded by Stansbery, to approve minutes of the October 20th, 2014 regular meeting. All Aye. Carried.
- Residential Facility Discussion In order to improve communication and understand the process of the Facility, Council invited Mark Smith and staff to come to this meeting. Smith started by handing out a factual sheet to the Council. Out of the 22 facilities in Iowa, West Union has some of the best statistics. To assist with the community understanding, they have set an Open House for December 11<sup>th</sup> from 1-3pm to tour the facility and ask questions.
- Adopt Ordinance 591-Cemetery With the recent resignation of the Cemetery Board, City Attorney Jerem White was asked to revise the Ordinance to proceed as the other departments currently operate, with the Cemetery reporting directly to the City Administrator. After some discussion, a motion was made by Granger, seconded by Gumm, to approve the First Read of the amended Ordinance as presented. All Aye. Carried.  
Motion was then made by Gumm, seconded by Keller, to waive the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Readings. All Aye. Carried.  
Gumm then made the motion to Adopt Ordinance 591 as presented, Keller seconded. All Aye. Carried.

- Adjourn With no further business to bring before the Council, a motion was made by Stansbery, seconded by Gumm, to adjourn. All Aye. Carried.
