How Does the Program Work?



The purpose of the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Incentive Program, offered by the Iowa Department of Economic Development and Main Street West Union, is to provide an additional financial incentive to property owners and tenants to implement energy efficiency improvements recommended in recently completed energy audits.

If you had an energy audit completed in August or September 2008, and have signed a consent and release form from both Alliant Energy and Black Hills Energy, you are eligible for the program. The incentives will be in the form of rebates offered upon completion of select energy efficiency and renewable energy improvements. Your participation in this special incentive program may reduce your energy use and costs, resulting in a positive impact on your operation's bottom line. In addition, your participation will help lead Iowa in its economic development, environmental sustainability, and greenhouse gas emission reduction efforts.



HOW MUCH IS THE REBATE?

The rebate amount varies by type of energy improvement made. The maximum rebate per utility account is \$3,000. Additional rebates may be available from your local service provider. Rebates are available for replacing an aging furnace, installing new energy star appliances, replacing windows and doors with energy star models, and upgrading lighting to more efficient fluorescent or LED fixtures. Additional funding is available through the DOE Grant Program for geothermal projects.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Rebates are provided on a first-come-first-serve basis. Funding is limited. All improvements must be completed by February 15, 2014 and claim forms submitted by March 1, 2014. Before making any improvements, please verify that funding remains by calling (563)422-8655. Rebate claims must be submitted within 30 days of completion of installation. Rebate request forms are available at the Chamber/Main Street office or online at www.westunion.com under the Green Pilot tab. Send the completed rebate form & supporting documentation to Main Street West Union, 115 1/2 North Vine Street, West Union, Iowa, 52175.

This special rebate program is the next step of a

long-term commitment to pilot economic and environmental sustainability concepts in West Union. Funding for this program has been provided by the Iowa Department of Economic Development and the USDA Renewable Energy Development Assistance grant. The program will be administered by Main Street West Union. Total funding available in Phase 2 will be \$40,000.
