

Council Chambers, West Union Library, May 2, 2016, 5:00 P.M.

West Union City Council met May 2, 2016 at 5:00 P.M. in Council Chambers with Mayor Kent Halverson presiding. The meeting began with citing the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Attendance Roll call: Present – Council members Keller, Gumm, Smith, Stansbery, and Granger. Absent: None
- Approval of the Agenda Motion was made by Stansbery, seconded by Granger, to approve the agenda with an amendment on #8 to change to “Public Hearing, Review and Award”. All Aye. Carried.
- Approval of the Minutes Motion was made by Granger, seconded by Stansbery, to approve minutes of the April 18, 2016, regular meeting as presented. All Aye. Carried.
- Approval Resol. 2016-28 to Approve Submitting IDOT GAVI Grant Application for Hangar Improvements Adam Keller advised this grant application is a 60/40 match for actual amount spent on improvements to the tee hangar. He put \$11,000 in the budget for this and has a couple local contractors interested in the roof repairs needed. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Stansbery, to approve the grant application as presented. All Aye. Carried.
- Approve Setting a Public Hearing for Budget Amendment Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Stansbery, to approve setting a Public Hearing for FY16 Budget Amendment for May 16, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. All Aye. Carried.
- Public Hearing & Award Water Tower Painting Five bids were received and opened at 11am May 2nd, 2016. Low bid was Utility Service, Perry, GA. Jon Biederman of Fehr Graham is checking references as he has not worked with them previously. Stansbery made a motion to open the Public Hearing, Granger seconded. All Aye. Carried. After no comments or questions, Keller made a motion to close the Public Hearing, Gumm seconded. All Aye. Carried. Council would like to wait in awarding the job to hear back on the references.
- Approve Setting a Public Hearing for Bid Letting on E. Plum Resurfacing Jon Biederman advised plans and specs went out last week, and will probably have 2 bidders on the project. Now that the frost has come out, there is more reconstruction needed. Teresa Pape advised she will be contacting the residents to coordinate sidewalk replacement at the same time. Motion was made by Granger, seconded by Gumm, to set the Public Hearing for May 16, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. All Aye. Carried.
