

Council Chambers, City Hall, October 3rd, 2022, 6:00 P.M.

West Union City Council met October 3rd, 2022 at 6:00 P.M. in Council Chambers with Mayor Cameron Granger presiding. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Agenda	Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Croal, to approve the agenda as presented. All Aye. Carried.
Approval of Minutes	Motion was made by Croal, seconded by Gumm to approve the September 19th, 2022 minutes. All Aye. Carried.
Approval of Lion's Club Request for Additional Funding	Tracy Weidemann presented to the council that they ended up doing more work to Lion's Park than they originally planned. They are also needing to replace the roof on the shelter building due to holes in the tin. They are requesting the City to help with roughly \$20,000 for the material for roof, and additional costs for what has been done. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Croal to approve Lion's Club additional need for funding up to \$20,000 out of the sidewalk fund. All Aye. Carried.
Public Hearing and Adopt Ordinance 609 Electric Transmission Franchise with ITC Midwest LLC	Granger opened public hearing for Ordinance 609 to establish a Franchise Agreement with ITC Midwest LLC. After no comment, Granger closed public hearing. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Croal to approve 1 st readings for Ordinance 609 Electric Transmission Franchise with ITC Midwest LLC. All Aye. Carried. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by McElree to waive 2 nd and 3 rd readings. All Aye. Carried. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by McElree to adopt Ordinance 609 Electric Transmission Franchise with ITC Midwest LLC. All Aye. Carried.
Approval of FY22 Street Finance Report	Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Croal to approve FY22 Street Finance Report. All Aye. Carried.
Approval on Cleaning Sewer Lines At Lift Station	Scott Johansen presented to council a contract with Municipal Pipe Tool for maintenance work for sewer lines. We must spend a minimum of \$3,000 a year due to contract. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by McElree to have Sewer Lines cleaned from E. Main to Lift Station and also by Echo Valley Apartments. All Aye. Carried.
Approval to Sell Sewer Dept Generator with Big Iron Auction	Jon Streif from Big Iron Auction would be able to sell a stationary generator at the next auction. He would charge City 10% commission of the sale. Motion was made by Croal, seconded by McElree to approve selling Sewer Dept Generator with Big Iron Auction. All Aye. Carried.
Discussion to Sell Excess Pavers stored At Imperial Roof	Currently the Pavers are at Tri-State Fireworks. Granger is going to call Terry to discuss if City can store them there. The pavers are for replacing street pavers as needed, so we don't want to sell them. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Croal to ask Tri-State Fireworks if we can store them at their location and not sell them. All Aye. Carried.
Approval to Apply for Catalyst Grant Funds	Matt Marsela presented to council a grant that the City would have to be the applicant for, but would be able to support a business in town to update any interior or exterior structures. The City would have to support the grant with some funding, or offer in-kind work. The max grant amount that could be received would be \$100,000. Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Croal to approve Applying for Catalyst Grant Funding for 2023 with reviewing this yearly. All Aye. Carried.
