Approval of the Agenda	Motion was made by Smith, seconded by Gumm, to approve the agenda as presented. All Aye. Carried.
Approval of Minutes	Motion was made by Gumm, seconded by Miller, to approve the September 25th, 2023, minutes. All Aye. Carried.
Resolution 2024-11 Payment of PPE#4 And Approve Change Order #2 to Ray's Excavating	Payment was requested by Ray's Excavating for work completed in September. Motion to approve payment of \$66,436.97 for PPE #4 and Change Order #2 for a net decrease of -\$10,245.57 for the Linden Street Sanitary Sewer Project 23-087 was made by Gumm, seconded by McElree. Discuss Adding a Pickleball Court In Rotary Park	Discussed option of adding a pickleball court to Rotary Park and also using as a hockey rink in the winter. Park and Rec Director Jaret Stellmaker will get more information on costs and funding. A DNR permit would also be needed for being in a flood plain. Tracy Weidemann is going to talk to Marge Crandall about adding pickleball courts to the current tennis courts at the Rec Center. A decision will be made when more information is available.
Resolution 2024-12 Use Fayette County Solid Waste Refund For the Linden Street Sanitary Sewer Project	Motion to approve the use of \$71,885.15 from Fayette County Solid Waste for the Linden Street Sanitary Sewer Project in the Capital Fund was made by Gumm, seconded by Smith. All Aye. Carried.
Approve Revolving Loan Funds For Brandon Fenneman And Lindsay Boyer	Brandon Fenneman is requesting \$75,000 in Revolving Loan Funds for the purchase of Anytime Fitness. Lindsey Boyer is requesting \$40,000.00 in Revolving Loan Funds for Ellbie Boutique. Motion to approve both loans at 5% for 7 years was made by Gumm, seconded by DeBack. All Aye. Carried.
Discuss Cross Walks On N. Pine St.	Parents in North Park Court requested cross walk signs be placed at the crosswalk from N. Park Ct. to the Rec Center entrance due to heavy traffic in the area. Street Superintendent Lee Barness will get prices on flashing cross walk signs and present at the next Council Meeting. Will also replace the other sets on N. Pine St. with flashing solar lights.
