West Union City Council met April 1, 2024, at 6:15 p.m. in Council Chambers with Mayor Cameron Granger presiding. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Discuss Mowing Bids	Discussed the mowing bid from Tieskoetter Lawn Care. Street Superintendent Lee Barness would prefer the Street Dept continue mowing the City properties. Motion to table the discussion was made by Gumm, seconded by McElree. All Aye. Carried.
Discuss Pavers and City Hall Parking Lot	Jon Biederman shared that it would not be beneficial to use the pavers from the downtown project in the City Hall parking lot. No action was taken.
Consider Approval of Recommendations From Planning and Zoning	Discussed recommendations from Planning and Zoning for updates to Zoning and to proceed with Annexation of 64-acre Property. After some discussion, Motion to table and review Comprehensive Plan was made by Miller, seconded by DeBack. All Aye. Carried.
