

Council Chambers, City Hall, June 3, 2024, at 6:00 P.M.

West Union City Council met June 3, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers with Mayor Cameron Granger presiding. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Attendance	Present: DeBack, McElree, Miller, and Tope. Absent: Gumm.
Approval of the Agenda	Motion to approve the agenda as presented was made by DeBack, seconded by McElree. All Aye. Carried.
Approval of Minutes	After some discussion, motion was made by Tope, seconded by DeBack, to approve the May 20, 2024, minutes as presented. All Aye. Carried.
Discuss Crosswalk Reconstruction in Downtown	Crosswalks need to be fixed due to pavers sinking. Cost estimate of \$39,918.00 to fix one crosswalk intersection was presented. Estimate given of \$16,700.00 if City does the labor. Zach was present from the Street Dept. and feels this would be better contracted due to equipment and labor. After some discussion, Council feels the sidewalk issues should be addressed first. Jeff Geertz has also been contacted at Iowa Economic Development to see if there is any assistance since we were a Pilot Project and would to see what he comes back with.
Consider Cahoy Pump Service Quote to Cap Well at 64-Acre	After some discussion, motion to table approval of Cahoy Pump Service quote to cap well at 64-acre property was made by Miller, seconded by Tope. All Aye. Water test needs to be done and more information attained.
Approval to Pay Unified Contracting Services for Airport	The function for the Airport Budget is really tight and no time to amend. City Administrator Johansen requested invoice from Unified Contracting Services for \$2,680.64 to replace mother board relay and pump relay board for fuel system at Airport be paid with Public Safety Funds. Motion to pay invoice from Public Safety Funds was made by McElree, seconded by DeBack. All Aye. Carried. Public Safety Funds will be paid back after July 1 <sup>st</sup> by Airport Funds.
Approval to Replace Furnace and Air at City Hall	Motion to approve replacing furnace and air conditioning at City Hall by Loomis Plumbing & Heating for \$6,548.16 was made by Tope, seconded by Miller. All Aye. Carried. (Approval was previously made by email due to air conditioning going out.)
Consider Approval to Covering Cost for Stand Up Rural America	Discussion on covering training cost for interested Economic Vitality Committee members for Stand Up Rural America hosted in Decorah. Motion to have WU Chamber decide if they want to sponsor instead of the City was made by McElree, seconded by Miller. All Aye. Carried.
Approval of Cigarette Permits for FY24-25	Motion to approve cigarette permits for FY24-25 for BP Xpress, Casey's, Dollar General, and Quillin's Quality Food was made by DeBack, seconded by Tope. All Aye. Carried.
Update of City 175th	Update on City 175 <sup>th</sup> Celebration was given by Amie Johansen. Discussed

Celebration travelling beverage trailers, swag, and alcohol licenses. Mayor's Breakfast will be held June 6 from 9:00-10:00 a.m. at Gus & Tony's as a kickoff event.

Approval of FY24 Motion to approve FY24 Transfers was made McElree, seconded by DeBack. All Aye. Carried.

Approval to Sell Councilman Matt McElree advised that property is owned by Iowa DOT from a Property at End of 1962 Deed and that the purchase would have to be discussed with Iowa DOT. Meadow Lane
